

Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Corporate Volunteerism Council of the Minneapolis/St, Paul Metro Area (CVC) is an association of corporations whose members have, or are creating, a method of promoting volunteerism within the corporate structure; and

WHEREAS: The Council was formed in 1980, and has grown from an initial core of six, to a total of 49 corporate members and 12 associate members from the non-profit sector; and

WHEREAS: Council associate members provide input and information on individual volunteer opportunities and projects; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota can be proud of enterprises such as the Corporate Volunteerism Council which underscore Minnesota's reputation as a state where people care about each other;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twenty-first day of December, 1989 to be
