WHEREAS: Esperanza Guerrero has served as a positive role model and a mentor to countless individuals and has been very active in community affairs; and

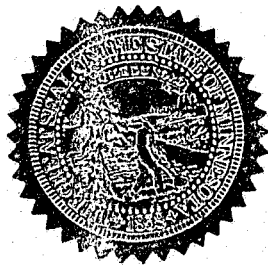
WHEREAS: She has received national recognition for her efforts and was named as one of the "100 most influential Hispanics in the United States;"
