Gordon Mikkelson has championed many conservation and environmental causes over the years and has been committed to the wise stewardship of all natural resources — land, soil, water, forests, wildlife, and fish; and WHEREAS:

He has helped further environmental education in Minnesota through the founding and WHEREAS:

promotion of the Deep Portage Conservation Reserve and has initiated environmental education scholarships for deserving young people; and

He was instrumental in the establishment of Voyageur's National Park in northern WHEREAS:

Under his leadership as co-chairman of the committee to redesign the parkways in Hennepin County, Hennepin Parks has become a model parks system; and WHEREAS:

His sincere and abiding interest in human rights helped break down racial barriers when he served as Chairman of the Minneapolis School Board, and has led him to promote Indian culture to others through education; and WHEREAS:

He was instrumental in establishing the concept of having a community college and a vo-tech college share the same campus within a core city where the facilities are accessible to all residents; and WHEREAS:
