

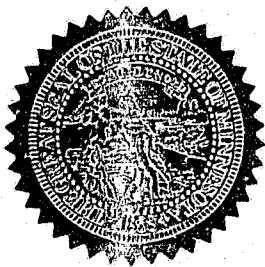


Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Over fifty percent of the students in Minnesota high schools participate in one or more extracurricular activity program; and
- WHEREAS: Participation in athletics, speech, music, debate, theatre and other school activities provides a constructive outlet for the energies and creative talents of young people; and
- WHEREAS: Extracurricular activities extend opportunities for socialization and interaction among high school students; and
- WHEREAS: High school activities directly benefit local communities by channeling the interests of young people in a positive manner; and
- WHEREAS: High school activities contribute toward developing well-rounded individuals and expanding the awareness and capabilities of high school students;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 29 through February 2, 1990 to be
