WHEREAS: It is fitting to set aside a day in recognition of IBM Rochester, which has contributed so much to the success of the business climate in the State of Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, January 18, 1990 to be

in Minnesota.


