WHEREAS: The inaugural event of the International Snowmobile Hall of Fame will be held in Grand Rapids which will recognize;

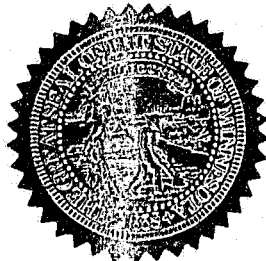
1. Inventors and manufacturers
