

Proclamation

WHEREAS: As the Executive Director of the Spanish Speaking Affairs Council of the State of Minnesota for the past 13 years, Jose Trejo has made many significant contributions to the State and to the Ilispanic community in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Through Jose's hard work and commitment to the Council, several programs to improve the socio-economic, educational and political status of Hispanics are now in place, including the Hispanic Education Program; the Minnesota Hispanic Chamber of Commerce; Instituto de Arte y Cultura; Minnesota Hispanic Leadership Project; Hispanic AIDS Partnership; Casa de Esperanza; Un Primer Paso; and others; and

WHEREAS: Jose is also dedicated to numerous committees and organizations, on which he has shown his ability as a leader, including the Midwest Hispanic AIDS Coalition; the Midwest Region of the National Latino AIDS Association; the National Association of State Hispanic Commissions; and many more; and

WHEREAS: Jose serves as a liaision for the Office of the President of Mexico and the midwestern states in promoting increased international trade and cultural, social and educational exhanges; and

WHEREAS: Jose received the Coalition Builder Award from the Minneapolis Urban Coalition, and was named as one of the top influential individuals in Saint Paul, by the Saint Paul Pioneer Press-Dispatch in 1985;
