WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota and the commonwealth of Australia possess a common view on the importance of education to social and economic development; and

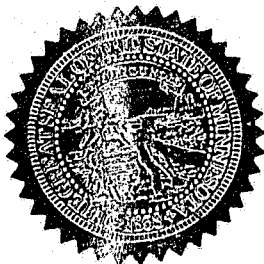
WHEREAS: Both have expressed confidence in the future prosperity of their people through continued mutual cooperation;
