WHEREAS: The sport of ice hockey is one of Minnesota's most popular sports, and has a rich history in this state; and

WHEREAS: There are more than 85,000 amateur hockey players in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Osseo/Maple Grove Invitational Hockey Tournament is the largest known hockey tournament in the world, involving 80 youth teams; and

WHEREAS: The Osseo/Maple Grove Invitational Hockey Tournament is now in its fourteenth year; and

WHEREAS: More than 5,000 people from Canada, Minnesota, and surrounding states travel to the Osseo/Maple Grove area for five weekends of competition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weekends of January 12-14, February 2-4, February 16-18, March 9-11, and March 16-18, 1990 to be
