WHEREAS: Since 1975, Ski For Light International, a Minnesota-based nonprofit, has promoted physical fitness and social well-being with blind and mobility impaired adults of all ages; and

WHEREAS: Disabled and non-disabled people join together to learn physically demanding outdoor activities in a one-to-one relationship while developing leadership skills to spread new fitness opportunities for disabled persons throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS: Ski for Light International returns to Minnesota, for the third time, to celebrate its fifteenth anniversary during a week-long program based at Cragun's Lodge, Brainerd, Minnesota, February 25 through March 4, 1990; and

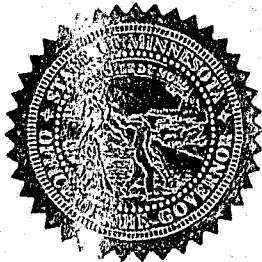
