WHEREAS: Tom Daniels has been highly visible in State and Federal politics for many decades as a citizen advocate and as an official photographer/staff person for many prominent leaders; and

WHEREAS: At the local level, Tom Daniels has generously given his time and expertise by serving on various Anoka County committees and boards; and

WHEREAS: Tom Daniels has also focused a great deal of attention to two special groups of constituents: handicapped and youth; and

WHEREAS: His contributions to handicapped include being the instrumental person in initiating, coordinating and managing improvements at the Islands of Peace Recreation Area and its programs for the handicapped along the Mississippi River; and
