

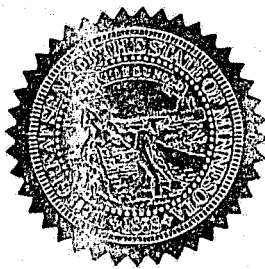


Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The ice sport of bandy is played by more than one million persons in the USSR; and
- WHEREAS: The USSR National Mens Bandy Team is the defending World Champion and is the finest bandy team in the world; and
- WHEREAS: At the invitation of the Minnesota Bandy Federation, the USSR National Team will be in the Twin Cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul from January 1-8, 1990; and
- WHEREAS: While in the Twin Cities the USSR National Team will play two games against the U.S. National Bandy Team and the USSR players will also play on American teams, together with American players, in the six-team Glasnost Cup, a unique sporting event; and
- WHEREAS: The visit of the USSR National Bandy Team will not only help promote and expand the sport of bandy in Minnesota and the United States, it will also enhance the friendship that already exists between the United States and USSR Bandy Federations; and
- WHEREAS: This is the first visit to the United States by any USSR bandy team;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 1-8, 1990 to be

in Minnesota.
