WHEREAS: Present and former volunteers of VISTA (Volunteers in Service to America) have served in Minnesota and other American communities for twenty-five years; and

WHEREAS: Their work in Minnesota has been to ameliorate and/or eliminate the deadening effects of poverty by working with low-income people in such diverse areas as the production of ethanol from corn; the establishment of centers for battered women; food banks and food shelves; and comprehensive programs for homeless people; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting to recognize these contributions and to honor the current thirty-seven volunteers now serving, as well as the former volunteers who have served over this period; and

WHEREAS: . . . The first VISTA volunteers entered service twenty-five years ago January 31, 1965;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the last week in January, 1990 to be

VISTA VOLUNTEER WEEK


in Minnesota.


