

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE
HONORABLE WILLIAM R. STURTZ, JUDGE OF
DISTRICT COURT, THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT,
STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA
STATUTES SECTIONS 490.126, SUBD. 2 AND
490.121, SUBD. 8.

WHEREAS, the Honorable William R. Sturtz, Judge of District
Court, Third Judicial District, State of Minnesota, has made
application to the governor by letter dated December 29, 1989 for
retirement effective April 30, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the said Honorable William R. Sturtz has served as Judge
of Probate and Juvenile Court for Freeborn County since June 30,
1969; Judge of County Court since July 1, 1972; and Judge of
District Court since June 13, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the said Honorable William R. Sturtz has satisfied the
necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes
Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of
business on April 30, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota
Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of
the Honorable William R. Sturtz, Judge of the District Court,
Third Judicial District, State of Minnesota, said retirement to
be made effective on April 30, 1990. He shall become entitled
thereafter to such retirement compensation provided under the
provisions of Minnesota Statutes 490. I hereby direct that this
Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the
State of Minnesota.
