- WHEREAS: Dr. Tobin G. Barrozo became the third president of Metropolitan State University in October, 1989; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Barrozo brings with him a dedication to education, and a commitment to continued success and expansion of Metropolitan State University, while recognizing all the university has to preserve, and build upon; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Barrozo envisions Metropolitan State University becoming a model urban university which features faculty, staff, and students working as partners with the community for the improvement of the quality of life in St. Paul and Minneapolis neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Barrozo comes to Metropolitan State University from Metropolitan State College in Denver, Colorado, where he was provost and vice president for academic affairs; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Barrozo made many outstanding contributions to Metropolitan State College, including formulating a plan for assessing college outcomes, integrating computers into the curricula, implementing a new General Studies Program, establishing an Honors Program and a Summer Bridge Program, and assisting in the development of the student affairs program; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Barrozo is a proven leader, whose skills and commitment promise to enhance Metropolitan State University's reputation for quality educational outcomes, and preserve its tradition of innovation and responsiveness;
