WHEREAS: Information is the dominant resource of the 1990's and beyond; and

WHEREAS: Accessible, accurate and timely information is critical to government decision-making;

and

WHEREAS: Using and managing information well is key to delivering government services; and

WHEREAS: Knowledgable workers within state and local government are the means by which information and information technology can reach their potential to serve all

Minnesotans;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 31, 1990 to be

GOVERNMENT INFORMATION PROFESSIONALS DAY

in Minnesota, in recognition of the dedication and professionalism of state employees who are bringing Minnesota into the information age.
