- WHEREAS:** The State of Minnesota is committed to enhancing the health of its employees and assisting in containing the rising cost of health care; and
- WHEREAS:** Since October of 1986, the Statewide Health Promotion Program has been developing, administering and coordinating a statewide health promotion program on behalf of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS:** The third annual Health Promotion on a Shoestring Conference will be held on Thursday, February 8 at the Earle Brown Conference Center on the University of Minnesota, St. Paul Campus; and
- WHEREAS:** The conference is being conducted by the Department of Employee Relations Statewide Health Promotion Program to generate increased health awareness among state employees; and
- WHEREAS:** Health promotion coordinators will attend and be introduced to the expanded Statewide Health Promotion Program which complies with new union contracts requiring health promotion for state employees; and
- WHEREAS:** These health promotion coordinators, who are responsible for initiating health promotion programs in their agencies, are making significant contributions to the improved working environment for state employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, February 8, 1990 to be
