



Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Minnesota Women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and
- WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and
- WHEREAS: Jeanette Milgrom grew up in the Netherlands during World War II, and as a young person lived through the terror of war, and sensed early on the injustice of oppression; and
- WHEREAS: Social change, in the direction of greater social justice, has been at the root of her work; her energy has been directed toward addressing womens' issues; and
- WHEREAS: Trained as a social worker, Jeanette has worked with low income youth in Neighborhood Houses, and has facilitated group mental health work with adult psychiatric patients in Holland, in England, and in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Jeanette has helped adults in her work as Assistant-Superintendent of the Minnesota Correctional Institution for Women in Shakopee, and has helped children in day care at the Children's Home in the Netherlands, and the Wilder Day Care Center in St. Paul; and
- WHEREAS: As Director of Consultation and Training for the Walk-In Counseling Center, she has made a significant impact on professional ethics and conduct by developing in-service training on appropriate staff-client relationships and boundaries; and
- WHEREAS: As a nationally recognized expert in the field of sexual abuse in therapy, Jeanette co-authored the book, Psychotherapists' Sexual Involvement with Clients: Intervention and Prevention; and contributed to, Its Never OK - A Handbook for Professionals on Sexual Exploitation by Counselors and Therapists; and
- WHEREAS: Through workshops, support and advocacy, she has helped bring about early community awareness of issues women face related to rape, incest, battering and sexual harassment;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim


to be A Marvelous Minnesota Woman of 1990 for her leadership on empowering women, and on fighting oppression, social injustice, and victimization.
