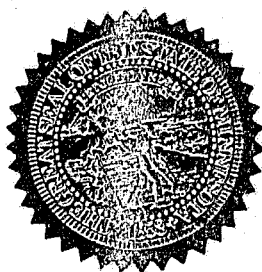
Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Fifteen percent of citizens of the city of Litchfield have disabilities; and
- WHEREAS: Architectural barriers deny citizens with disabilities the opportunity to work, travel, attend school, participate in community activities and contribute to the local economy; and
- WHEREAS: Disabled citizens of Litchfield have the same inalienable rights and responsibilities as all other citizens; and
- WHEREAS: The City Council of Litchfield passed a resolution stating its commitment to increasing the acceptance, dignity and full participation of persons with disabilities; and
- WHEREAS: The Access Litchfield conference, "Community Accessibility," further demonstrates Litchfield's commitment and leadership in the area;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, January 30, 1990 to be

LITCHFIELD ACCESS DAY

in Minnesota.
