WHEREAS: Magdalene Renz's philosophy of life is best expressed by her belief that helping people learn to laugh will contribute to a long life;

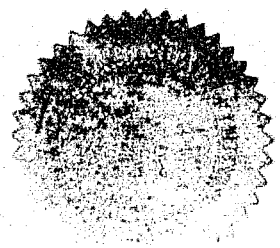
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the third week of February to be
