WHEREAS: Minnesota Women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and

WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota exports talented women to other states - such as Oregon, where Margie Hendriksen served in both the Oregon House of Representatives and State Senate, authored pay equity legislation, and was the Democratic Nominee for the U.S. Senate; and

WHEREAS: Margie has since returned to her home state of Minnesota, and served as Special Assistant Attorney General, managing the Public Utilities Division; and

WHEREAS: She has assisted in the lobbying effort of the Attorney General for legislation leading to the prevention of sexual violence against women; has served as a board member of the Minnesota Women's Political Caucus; and has assisted women candidates with her expertise throughout Minnesota;
