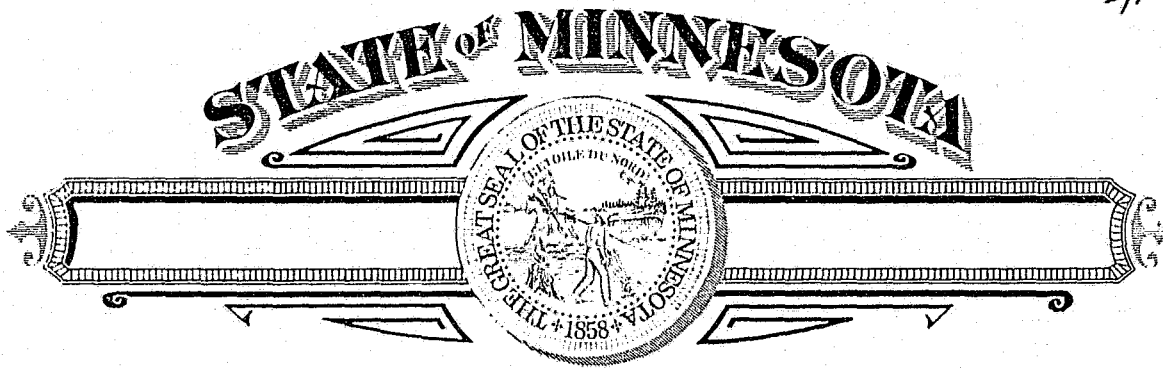

MINNESOTA IRS-SPONSORED VOLUNTEER WEEK

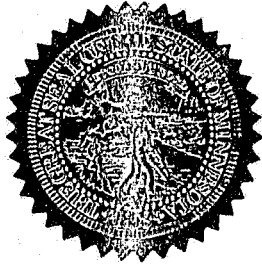
