WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Federation for Jewish Service will join together an unprecedented number of Minnesotans to show support for Israel in these historic times; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Mitzvah tour will provide participants with information on the intifada, the absorption of Russian immigrants, and the controversy surrounding Israel's Law of Return; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the trip is to broaden horizons and to promote international peace and understanding; and

WHEREAS: In recent years, Minnesota has distinguished itself by sending a record number of its community members on trips to Israel; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Mitzvah sponsored by the Minneapolis Federation for Jewish Service is helping to sharpen Minnesotans' understanding of the region's history, current situation, and future;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 18 through 26, 1990 to be

MINNESOTA MITZVAH DAYS

in Minnesota.
