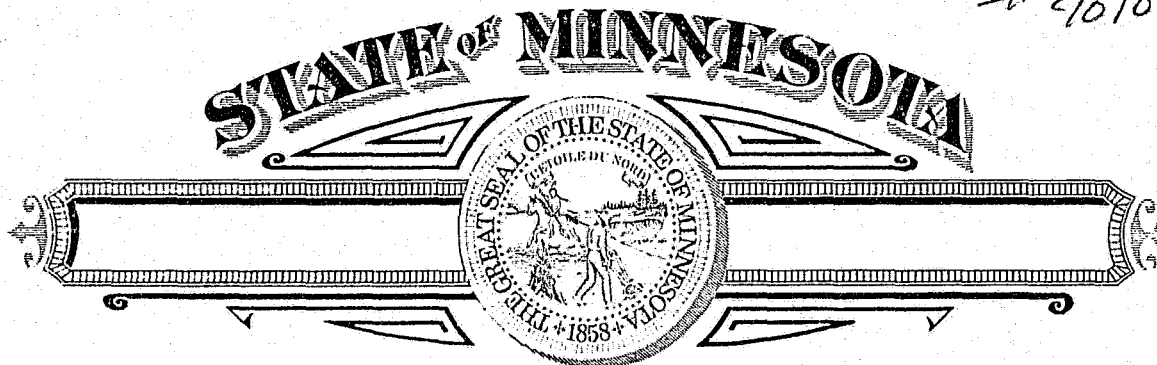

WHEREAS: The free market distribution of lumber and building materials provides for the basic housing needs for Minnesotans and all Americans; and

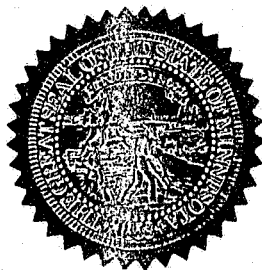
WHEREAS: Northwestern Lumbermen's Association this year will celebrate 100 years of service to its retail members and suppliers;
