- WHEREAS: Receiving a quality education is one of the most important things in life; and
- WHEREAS: Each year quality schools across the country are nominated for consideration at the national level for the School Recognition Program; and
- WHEREAS: The nominations are reviewed by the United States Department of Education for eligibility and completeness, and then reviewed by a National Review Panel, who then meets in Washington to recommend schools for site visits; and
- WHEREAS: Selected schools are then given two-day visits by a two-person site team, both of whom have extensive public and private school experience; and
- WHEREAS: The site team verifies the accuracy of the information in the nomination form, meets with parents, teachers, support staff, school and district administrators, and students, and do classroom observations; and
- WHEREAS: The site teams then forward their reports to the Review Panel, which meets again, and selects a final group of schools for recognition as a National School of Excellence; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

PETER HOBART SCHOOL

to have been selected as a National School of Excellence in 1988.
