#### ORDINANCE NO. 176

#### AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS

#### OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 414.033, Subd. 5, the City Council of the City of Watertown heretofore accepted a Petition for Annexation of certain land into the corporate limits of the City of Watertown as hereinafter The Petition was made by all of the owners of said described. land and copies of the Petition were filed as required by law with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Watertown, and the Carver County Board of Commissioners. The Board of Supervisors of Watertown Township consented to the annexation and waived the 90 day waiting period. The City Council determined that said land abuts the present corporate limits of the City of Watertown; that said land is part of the plat of Watertown and does not exceed 200 acres in area; that said land is not now included within any municipality nor does said land border any other municipality; that said land is now or is about to become urban or suburban in character; that said land is conditioned as properly to be subject to municipal government; and that the annexation of said land will be in the best interest of the City of Watertown and the land to be annexed.

Section 2. THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN ARE DECLARED HEREBY EXTENDED TO ENCOMPASS AND INCLUDE ALL THAT CERTAIN LAND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

> That part of the original plat of the Town of Watertown designated and marked thereon as "cemetery".

> Together with those parts of Stevens Street, High Street, and Jackson Avenue lying adjacent to said "cemetery" not already within the corporate limits of the City of Watertown as shown on the map of said land attached hereto and made a part hereof.


Section 3. The City Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Auditor, and the Minnesota Secretary of State and to publish this Ordinance in the Carver County News, all as required by law. <u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance takes affect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3 and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
