ORDINANCE NO. 964

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WILLMAR, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 40 ACRES.

WHEREAS, the within described lands abut the city limits of the City of Willmar and are more than sixty (60%) percent surrounded by the city limits of the City of Willmar; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute Section 414 et seq. allows for annexation by ordinance of tracts of land abutting the city limits and sixty (60%) percent or more surrounded by the City; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed to annex by this Ordinance to the City of Willmar, said property, all of which is located in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed consists of approximately 7.21 acres, more or less, described as follows, to-wit:

Government Lot 1 of Section 2, Township 119, Range 35.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Willmar does hereby ordain as follows:

- Section 1. BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY OF WILLMAR AND AREA TO BE ANNEXED. That the annexation will be in the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
- Section 2. ABUTS ON CITY LIMITS. That the property above described abuts on the city limits, and is so conditioned as property to be subject to city government.
- Section 3. SIXTY (60%) PERCENT SURROUNDED. That the property above described is more than Sixty (60%) percent surrounded by the city limits of the City of Willmar.
- Section 4. ANNEXATION. That the said property is hereby annexed to, and included within, the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.
- Section 5. ZONING. That portion of the above described property existing as public right-of-way shall be zoned P-Park, and the balance of the property shall be zoned GB-General Business.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be filed and Section 6. shall take effect and be of full force and effect from and after filing a certificate thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County of Kandiyohi, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and from and after this adoption and publication.
