

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION BY THE HONORABLE
ROBERT A. FORSYTHE, DISTRICT COURT JUDGE OF THE
FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT, STATE OF MINNESOTA,

WHEREAS, The Honorable Robert A. Forsythe, having made
application to the said undersigned Governor Rudy Perpich, in a
letter dated April 2, 1990, for full retirement at the close of
business on October 31, 1991, and for an extension of his present
term until said date; and

WHEREAS, the said Judge Robert A. Forsythe will have served
continuously as Municipal Court Judge since September 7, 1982 and
as District Court Judge since June 19, 1986; and


WHEREAS, the said Judge Robert A. Forsythe will have reached
the age of 70 years on October 31, 1991; and


WHEREAS, M.S. 490.101, Subd. 4, requires the Governor to
make a written order accepting such retirement application and
extending such term of office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, acting pursuant to the aforementioned statutes do
hereby order that the present term of office for said Judge
Robert A. Forsythe be, and it hereby is, extended to and including
October 31, 1991 and further order that retirement benefits com-
mence, as provided by law, at the close of business on the 31st
day of October, 1991.
