by enemy forces; and

WHEREAS: These prisoners of war from the Civil War through the conflicts of the present century,

have survived their ordeal; and

These men bore valiantly the cruelties of their captors, and the loss of their freedom; WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: They are imminently deserving of the recognition of their fellow citizens, and have

earned the right to wear their "badges of courage" proudly;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 9, 1990 to be
