

Proclamation

March 13, 1990 has been designated as the Challenger Math Science Awareness Day in WHEREAS:

WHEREAS:

The Challenger Math Science Awareness Day is designed to develop an awareness that the necessary mathematical and science skills must be effectively acquired by all students to enable them to be successful in the next century; and

We need to nurture all students interests and skills in science, mathematics, and WHEREAS: technology by teachers at all levels, pre-school through graduate school; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota colleges and universities will improve their efforts to increase their ratio of technical graduates to science and engineering careers to meet the employment needs of Minnesota industries by the year 2000; and

WHEREAS: We must improve efforts to assist women who currently comprise 52% of the U.S. population, and are only 27.4% of all U.S. scientists and only 4.3% of all engineers, to persist in mathematics and science in the education pipeline; and

We must improve efforts to assist Blacks, Hispanics, and Native Americans who make up 20.4% of the total U.S. population, and are only 5% of the U.S. professional science and engineering workforce, to persist in mathematics and science in the education WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: We must improve efforts of Minnesota High Schools to offer a second year of calculus,

WHEREAS: A comprehensive state vision for women and minorities is to increase their participation in science and mathematics in relation to their percentage of the entire population by the year 2000;
