



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Clinton Hill was an eleven-year-old boy with a big dream; and
- WHEREAS: Clinton's hope was that kids could save the Earth and all its creatures from pollution by acting on their desire for a cleaner, healthier planet; and
- WHEREAS: Before Clinton died of a malignant brain tumor November 27, 1989, he had planned to become a scientist and inventor to help save the Earth, and had drawn pictures of a pollution reversal machine that he wanted to invent; and
