WHEREAS: The Mino Bimadisiwin program is designed to develop positive leadership skills, prevent Indian family breakups and enhance self awareness; and

WHEREAS: The Mino Bimadisiwin program is hosting the First Annual Indian Youth Family Leadership Conference at Macalester College on March 17, 1990; and

WHEREAS: The focus of this conference is to provide Indian youth and families with positive Indian leadership role models; and

WHEREAS: The Keynote speaker is Billy Mills, 10,000 meter Olympic gold medalist who will be introduced by the U.S. Olympic Festival-'90 President and Executive Director, Jack Kelly, who will honor Mr. Mills at this youth family conference as the only American to hold the gold medal in the 10,000 meter race;
