



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Joe Larson has been a farmer for over 42 years; he and his wife Blanch and their son Jerry own and operate a 1,000 acre dryland wheat, barley, and potato farm in the Red River Valley near Climax, Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Joe has served as a township clerk, a local Farmers Union president, been active in the Red River Valley Potato Growers, the Climax Community Club, the Climax Development Association and has been a member of the Farmers Union Central Exchange (CENEX) since 1960; and
- WHEREAS: He served as First Vice-Chairman of the CENEX board from 1968-1976, when he was elected Chairman of the board, a position in which he served for ten years; and
- WHEREAS: During his years with CENEX, Joe proved his ability as a leader; his dedication to the farmers of America; and his deep care and concern for others; and
- WHEREAS: During the period which Joe was serving as the CENEX board chair, no other regional cooperative was more innovative, saw more consistent growth, or had a better financial record than CENEX, which has consistently been on the list of Fortune magazine's top 500 U.S. corporations, and is one of the nation's leading regional cooperatives; and
- WHEREAS: Joe was selected as the recipient of the 1990 National Farmers Union "Meritorious Service to Farmers Union and American Agriculture" award;
