WHEREAS: Minnesota Women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and

WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS: As a Duluth School Board member from 1973-1983, Mary Ryland championed girls athletic programs, and sought to provide opportunities for advancement of women throughout the Duluth School system; and

WHEREAS: Mary serves as AAUW co-chair for Choices for Tomorrow's Women; as chair of the Minnesota State Advisory Committee to the United States Commission on Civil Rights; and is co-owner of Ryland Ford, Inc.;
