



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Bureau of Cultural Affairs of the City of Perpignan, France has invited the Minnesota State Band to perform in their Theatre Municipal de Perpignan on March 26, 1990; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Band is the official state band and Minnesota's Ambassadors of Goodwill; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota holds strong cultural ties with France and its citizens — our state motto is "L'etoile Du Nord", "Star of the North," because Minnesota is the northern-most state in the nation, and in recognition of its French history; and

WHEREAS: The concert by the Minnesota State Band in Perpignan is in recognition of the French people and their strong ties to Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 24, 1990 to be
