



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The International Institute of Minnesota has served the people of the State of Minnesota for the past seventy years as a non-political, interfaith, interracial social service agency which serves both foreign and native-born through an integrated program of casework, legal services, intergroup relations and education, and promotes friendship and understanding between individuals and groups of diverse cultural backgrounds; and

WHEREAS: The International Institute has produced the Festival of Nations since 1932 which has served to stimulate awareness and understanding of the ethnic groups in the State of Minnesota and to strengthen ethnic groups as they work together toward a common goal, and to promote friendships among people of diverse backgrounds as they work side-by-side in a display of unity; and

WHEREAS: Robert J. Hoyle has served the International Institute of Minnesota as Executive Director for the past twenty years, and has evidenced a commitment to serving people in transition through work in the Peace Corps and in resettlement efforts in Minnesota, and has been active in community affairs of the city of St. Paul and the State of Minnesota through a host of volunteer organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 28, 1990 to be
