

and Commissioner Bergemann seconded the motion to adopt the following resolution establishing Blue Earth County Regional Railroad Authority:

Be it resolved, that Blue Earth County hereby organizes and establishes the Blue Earth County Regional Railroad Authority pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 398A, the Regional Railroad Authority pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 398A, the Regional Railroad Authorities Act, as a political subdivision and local government unit of Minnesota to exercise thereunder part of the sovereign power of the state; that the board of commission and the state and the state of t of the authority shall be five (5) and the first board of commissioners for the authority shall be the current members of the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners,

That the registered office of the Blue Earth County Regional Railroad Authority is to be situated in the City of Mankato; that neither the State of Minnesota, Blue Earth County, or any political subdivision is liable for the obligations of the Blue Earth County Regional Railroad Authority; and that the purpose of the Blue Earth County Regional Railroad Authority is the preservation and improvement of local rail service in accordance with the powers and authorities granted in Minnesota Statutes Chapter 398A and resolution.

The motion carried. (Administration) 90-319

Commissioner Landkamer moved and Commissioner More seconded the motion that the first meeting of the Blue Earth County Regional Railroad Authority be held on the 17th day of April, 1990, immediately following the Blue Earth County Board meeting. purpose of the first meeting would be to consider proposed bylaws and to elect officers and appoint an executive director. The motion carried unanimously. (Administration) 90-320
