



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The 72nd Anniversary of the Declaration of Independence of Bielarus will be observed by Bielarusan Americans throughout the United States and by those living in other parts of the free world on March 25; and

WHEREAS: Bielarus, a republic of the Soviet Union, and Communist controlled from Moscow and known to the outside world under the Russian name of Byleorussia, is bordered by Poland, Ukraine, Russia and the Baltic States; and

WHEREAS: In a continuing struggle for freedom and independence, Bielarusians are a freedom loving people who, since 1922, have been subjected to Russianization at its highest level; and

WHEREAS: Bielarusan Americans cannot remain indifferent to the plight of those still living under enslavement and, therefore, seek to promote their heritage and uphold the idea of freedom and independence of their homeland;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 25, 1990 to be

BIELARUSIAN INDEPENDENCE DAY

in Minnesota.
