



Proclamation

- HEREAS: Cancer is the second leading cause of death in the nation, and this year there will be approximately 16,900 new cases among men, women and children of all ages in Minnesota; and
- HEREAS: The American Cancer Society has helped improve the chances for survival through its research programs, and has provided comfort and support through its service and rehabilitation program to improve the quality of life for all cancer patients; and
- HEREAS: Prevention and early detection measures have been identified by medical experts as key strategies in the fight against cancer; and
- HEREAS: The American Cancer Society will embark on a campaign during the month of April to bring local citizens important information about cancer which could reduce their risk of getting the disease, or help ensure detection early enough for cure; and
- HEREAS: The Minnesota Division of the American Cancer Society provides support for important medical research in order to finally eliminate the suffering and death from cancer;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 1-30, 1990 to be

Minnesota, and urge every citizen to support the American Cancer Society's Annual Community usade.
