WHEREAS: Capitol Child Care is the state's first on-site child care center for children of state government employees; and

WHEREAS: Children are Minnesota's top priority, and the state is a leader in child care issues; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota faces a critical shortage of quality child care; and

WHEREAS: The number of working parents in need of child care has increased, and the availability of quality care has not kept pace with demand; and

WHEREAS: State government benefits in improved productivity and employee morale when child care needs of employees are addressed; and

WHEREAS: Capitol Child Care demonstrates Minnesota's ongoing commitment to child care and development;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 20, 1990 to be

CAPITOL CHILD CARE DAY

in Minnesota, in honor of the dedication of Capitol Child Care.
