- WHEREAS: Civitan International was founded 70 years ago in Birmingham, Alabama on April 15, 1920; and
- WHEREAS: The 50,000 men, women and teenagers in 1600 Civitan Clubs worldwide work together to make their communities better places in which to live and work; and
- WHEREAS: Civitan has contributed millions of dollars to aid the mentally retarded and physically handicapped in our community and throughout the world; and
- WHEREAS: Civitan club projects prepare adults and young people for meaningful involvement in civic and public affairs; and
- WHEREAS: Civitan stresses the principles of good citizenship and challenges all of us to think of citizenship as both a privilege and a responsibility; and
- WHEREAS: Civitan is recognized for its support of adult and youth leadership development programs, community enhancement projects, scholarship grants and public education programs; and
- WHEREAS: The Civitan clubs of Minnesota do the good work of Civitan in their own communities;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 9-15, 1990 to be
