WHEREAS: Harry S. Truman, the 33rd President of the United States, and one of this country's most respected statesman, was born on May 8, 1884; and

WHEREAS: The Truman presidency was marked by some of the most profound events in human history, including the first use of atomic bombs, the end of World War II with the defeat of Japan, the first hydrogen bomb explosion, the Korean War, the establishment of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, inauguration of the Marshall Plan to aid Europe and the establishment of the Truman Doctrine to aid countries threatened by communism; and

WHEREAS: Throughout his presidency, Mr. Truman was noted for his total dedication to the people and principles of the United States and for his forthright defense of freedom and justice for other countries and peoples; and
