WHEREAS: Judge Rainer Weis is husband to Mary Weis, father to John, Ann, Paul, Susan, Mark, Peter, Julia, and Jeffrey, and grandfather to Benjamin and Emily; and

WHEREAS: Judge Rainer Weis has practiced law since 1959, when he graduated from William Mitchell College of Law, and began working with a law firm in Willmar, Minnesota; and
