



Proclamation

WHEREAS: April 22-28, 1990 is Volunteer Recognition Week in Minnesota, a time to give special recognition to the valuable and varied activities of volunteers; and

WHEREAS: Local and regional volunteerism has been a cornerstone of statewide volunteer efforts, making Minnesota a nationally recognized leader and innovator in volunteer services; and

WHEREAS: The Metropolitan Council could not function as it does without the help and commitment of volunteers, who play a crucial role in maintaining the region's vitality and improving the quality of life for all Twin Cities area residents; and

WHEREAS: Recognition should be given to volunteers who contribute to public policy development by advising the council in such areas as housing, health, regional parks, land use issues, solid waste, transportation, the arts, services to the elderly, minority community issues and development disabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 26, 1990 to be
