said newspaper has been:

- (1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language, and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three-quarters inches long.
- (2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same.
- (3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter or advertisements, or any or either of them.
- (4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that

prior to the date of the first publication of said Ordinance

the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said county of Hennepin, state of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in Section 3 of Chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE MUNICIPAL NAME OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST MINNEAPOLIS TO THE VILLAGE OF HOPKINS.

The Village Council of the Village of West Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the municipal and incorporated name of the Village of West Minneapolis be and is hereby changed to the corporate and municipal name of the Village of Hopkins, Hennepin County, Minnesota, to correspond with the name "Hopkins" of the post-office in such village as designated by the United States Postal Authorities, and also to correspond with the name "Hopkins" designated as the name of the railroad stations in such Village.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication, and upon the filing of a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota, and with the State Auditor and the Secretary of State of Minnesota.
