



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The nation is celebrating National Transportation Week from May 13-19; and

WHEREAS: Each year transit provides over 60,000 rides to work for rural and metropolitan Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: Transit is often the only means of transportation to life-sustaining goods and services which are vital to many people, especially the elderly and disabled; and

WHEREAS: Transit employs approximately 3,000 people in Minnesota and expends approximately \$138 million annually in employment payroll, goods and services; and

WHEREAS: Transit plays a significant role in reducing urban traffic congestion;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 16, 1990 to be
