



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The roots of the game of golf in Minnesota extend back to the late 1800's; and

WHEREAS: A small group of Minnesota women from Town & Country Club, Minikahda Club, Interlachen Country Club, White Bear Yacht Club and Northland Country Club met at Minikahda Club September 22, 1915; and

WHEREAS: Because of their common interest in the game of golf, they founded the Women's Minnesota Golf Association, an organization for the purpose of planning and conducting tournaments, association days and league competition; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Women's Golf Association grew from that early organization, which was incorporated in 1939, and rededicated to the general promotion of golf and the enjoyment thereof for women; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Women's Golf Association has continued to grow in stature, and currently conducts five major women's golf championships in the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 18, 1990 to be
