



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Concerned United Birthparents (C.U.B.) of Minnesota wants to be recognized as a concerned and viable part of the Adoption Triad; and

WHEREAS: Every adopted person has birthparents; and

WHEREAS: All adopted persons have a right to the knowledge of their genetic origins; and

WHEREAS: We, the birthparents, are the resource of this genetic information; and

WHEREAS: All family members, including adoption-separated families, have the right to know each other; and

WHEREAS: CUB of Minnesota is committed to the goal of educating, for the purpose of affecting positive adoption reform;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 1 through April 7, 1989, to be

NATIONAL BIRTH PARENT WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge that all local and state social service agencies, and the citizenry at large support the desire of birthparents to become a working and viable part of the adoption process.
