WHEREAS: Medical research has made much progress in recent years in its search to find a cure for cancer; and

WHEREAS: Ten years ago the city of St. Paul's cancer survival rate was thirty percent; today it has increased to forty-nine percent; and

WHEREAS: Across the nation cancer survivors, together with their families, friends and other supporters, are celebrating life; and

WHEREAS: National Cancer Survivors' Day helps convey the message of hope that people DO survive cancer;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 29, 1990 to be

NATIONAL CANCER SURVIVORS DAY

in Minnesota, and I ask all citizens to join in celebrating this victorious milestone in the fight against cancer.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ninety and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
