
GOVERNOR'S ORDER EXTENDING PROTECTION TO DEER IN
MORRISON COUNTY

Whereas, it has been represented to the Game and Fish Commissioner that deer are in danger of undue depletion in the county of Morrison, State of Minnesota, and

Whereas, the Game and Fish Commissioner has investigated and has presented me with the results of his investigation, and has recommended that protection be given deer in Morrison County to prevent their undue depletion.


Now, Therefore, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134, Chapter 400, S. L. Minnesota, 1919, do hereby order that no deer be taken in the county of Morrison, State of Minnesota, during the season of 1928.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1929 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
